On 14th April 1912 RMS Titanic struck an iceberg in the North Atlantic on her maiden voyage from Southampton. She began to sink immediately, resulting in the deaths of 1,517 people in one of the deadliest peacetime maritime disasters in history.

On the 100th anniversary, **Southampton Concert Orchestra** and **Contemporary Music for All** present a special programme of music to commemorate and remember this tragic event.

Southampton Concert Orchestra (Southampton's oldest established amateur symphony orchestra), performs classical music of the period to invoke an impression of the ocean with **Mendelssohn's Hebrides Overture**, then the vision of the destination America with **Dvorak's New World Symphony**, and finally the pathos of the tragedy, with **Mahler's Adagietta from Symphony No. 5**.

Contemporary Music for All (enabling amateur musicians to perform modern music in live settings) performs a work by living composer Gavin Bryars called *The Sinking of the Titanic*, composed in 1969 and now especially re-arranged. Coloured lighting effects will enhance the sound, and pictures of original film footage will be projected on the walls to create a unique experience re-creating the event.

Southampton Guildhall is in the Civic Centre, Southampton. Car parks are nearby at Grosvenor Square and West Park Road. Southampton Central railway station is 10 minutes walking distance. Most Bus routes serve the Civic Centre. For full travel details and a map visit www.livenation.co.uk/southampton.
